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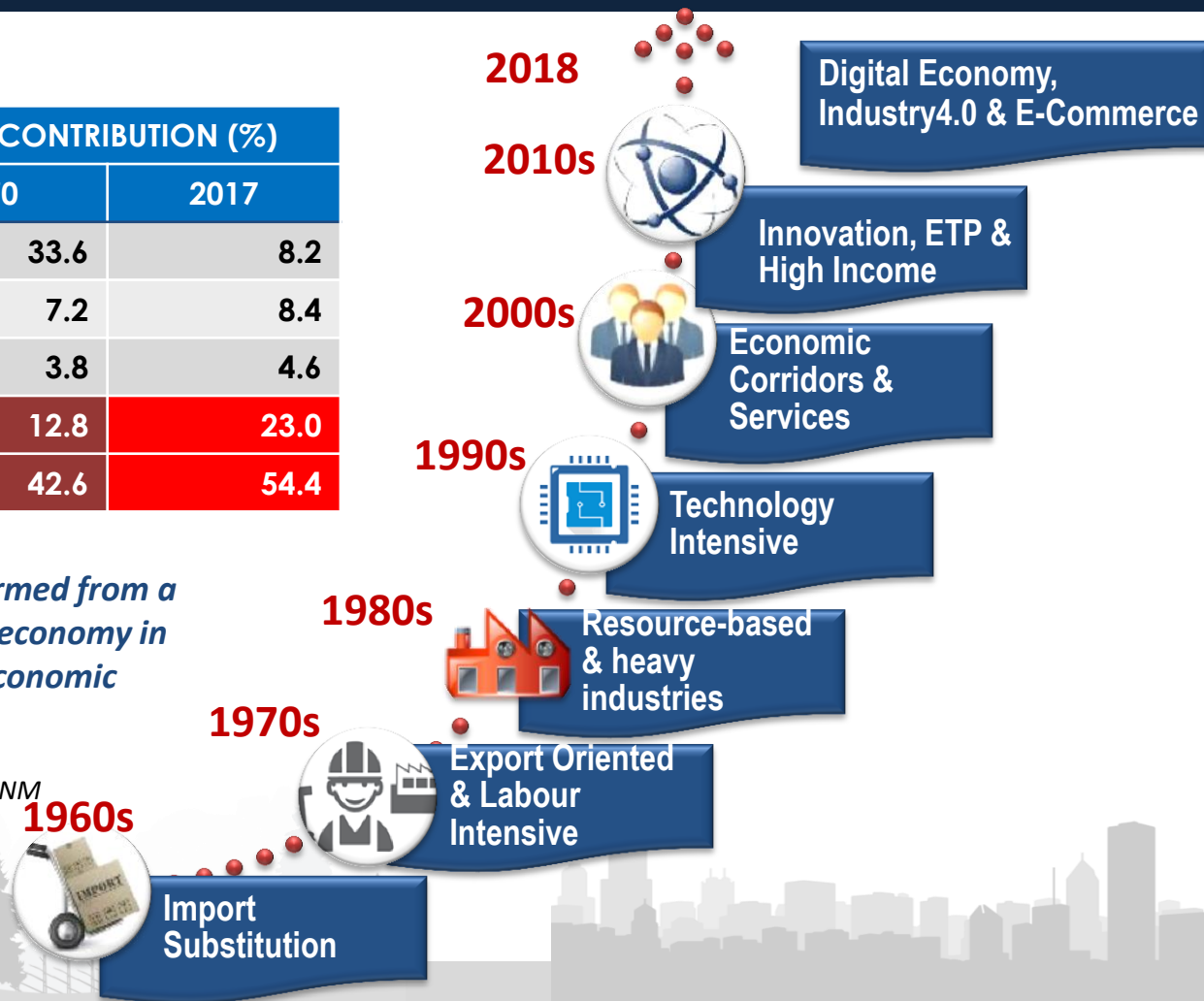

60% on qualifying capital expenditure incurred for 15 consecutive years

Less Developed Area

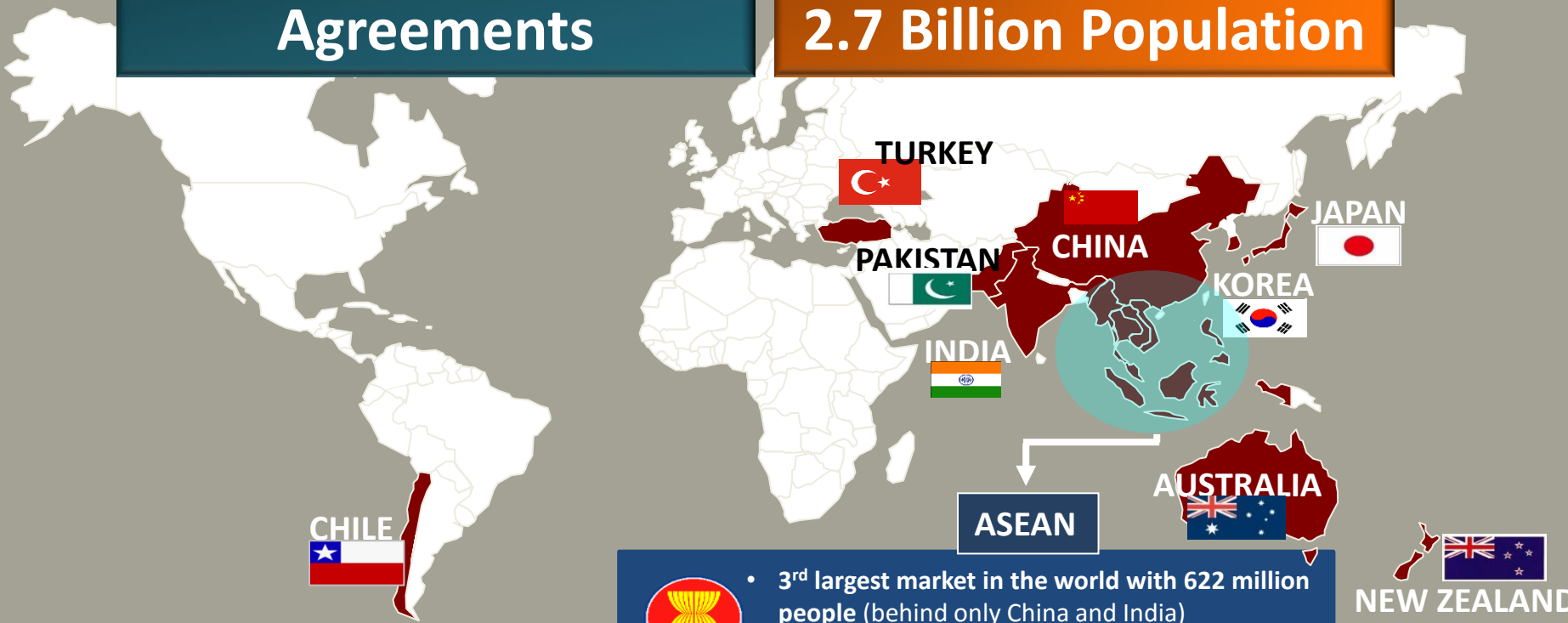
100% income tax exemption for up to 15 years or income tax exemption equivalent to 100% of qualifying capital expenditure incurred within 10 years

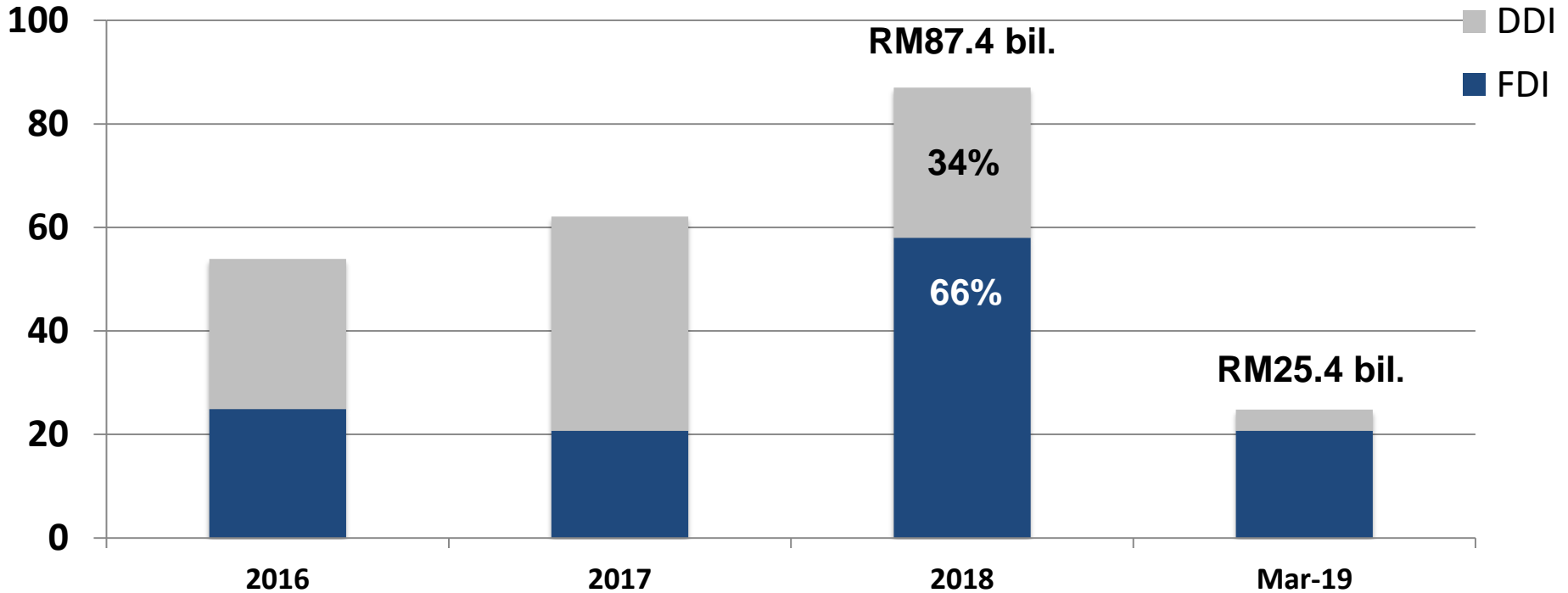

(2016 -Mar 2019)

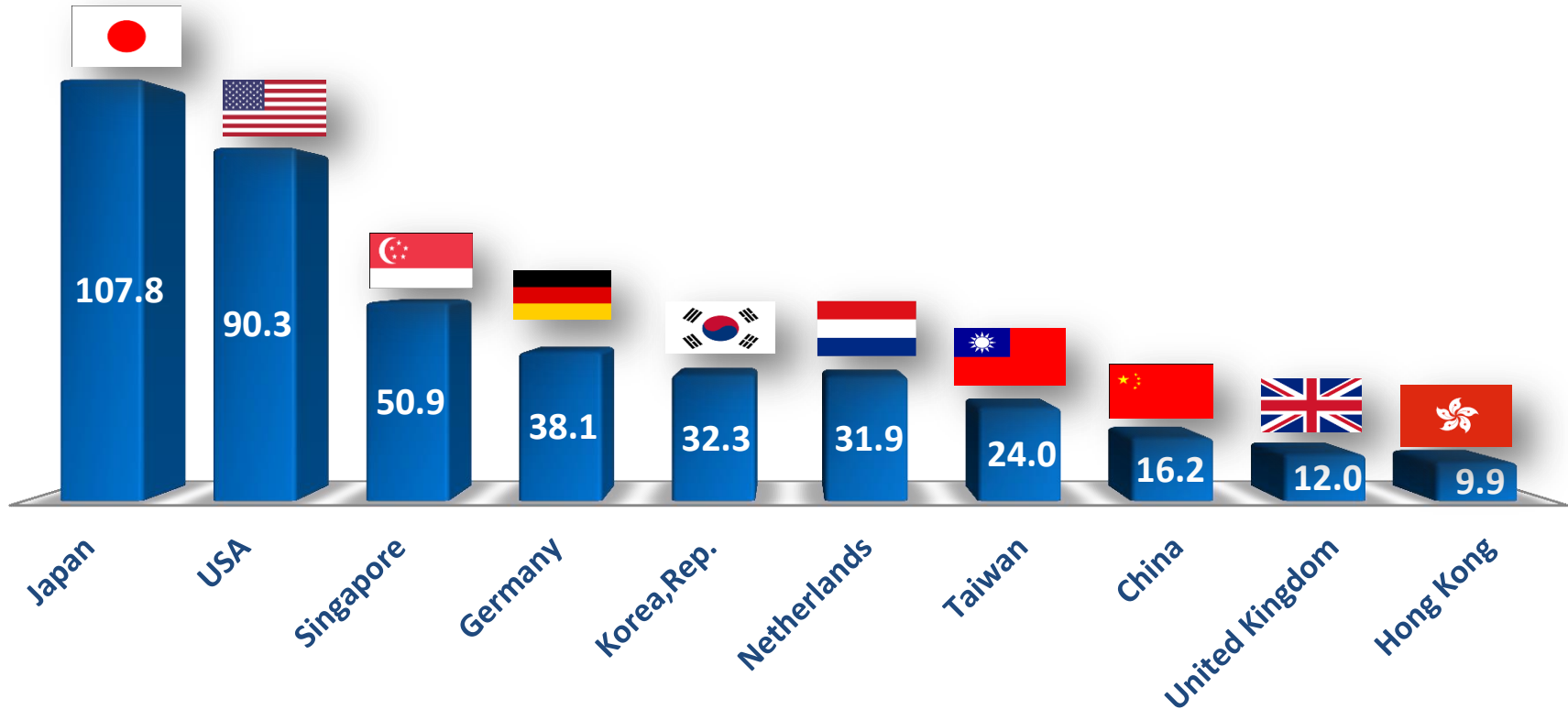
